After a special trip with extended family, they had a 2-hour flight to take before arriving at their other parents/ grandparents' home on Saturday. Plans changed. For our Global Outreach partners on furlough, theirs was one of thousands of canceled flights due to the global tech outage. As of this writing, the family are booked to fly in on Wednesday. Then, on August 4th, they fly back to their home-abroad.

Our Almighty God hears all their discouragements and disappointments. He feels their frustrations and fatigue. Matthew 11:28 states, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened and I will give you rest."

Back at their home-abroad, the Lord has used this family to allow hope to grow and healing to take place. Recently, six women gathered to courageously share their trauma in a safe space. S shared in their newsletter, "Through the group, these women
