1.	An unborn child is a distinct person, Hosea 12:3, Luke 1:41-44
2.	An unborn child has with a person (lex talionis), Exodus 21:22-25
3.	God knew us before we were conceived, Jeremiah 1:5, Psalm 139:13-16, Hosea 12:3
4.	Personhood/life/God's image begins with God's, Genesis 2:7, John 20:22
