If you've got it, then consider using your gifts and skills for Journey's Global Outreach Team (GoT). GoT oversees Journey's missionary funding, prays for and communicates with the workers/missionaries on the field regularly on your behalf, receives updates from them and then communicates information about their work to the church through the GoT foyer monitor. Also, whenever the workers are in town, GoT will also arrange for meet-n-greet opportunities for the church and the workers to get together.

The GoT ministry is made up of 2 parts that you could get involved in:

- The 1st part provides for the prayer support, needs and administrative support between Journey & the workers. Because it is tasked with being a good steward of Journey's funding for the workers, this part requires being a church member.
- The 2nd part is the auxiliary arm that helps support GoT work, for example, with the foyer GoT monitor, and the meet-n-greet get-togethers. You do not need to be a member of the church to be a part of this auxiliary arm of the GoT ministry.

Want to be involved in the auxiliary part of GoT? If you've got design and/or computer skills, then GoT could use your help, in creating content for the GoT foyer monitor, about the workers and their work. OR If you've got a heart to help, then GoT could use your help, whether it is in decorating & room prep, cooking/ food prep, and everything that happens in between.

If you are a church member, and **got a heart** for the Journey workers/missionaries in the field and their work, then consider joining GoT. If you've **got prayer**, then thank you and all the church groups who have a specific worker to pray for, for all your continued prayer support for our 9 workers in the field.

- b. That He will protect you & others from temptations to doubt Him or fall away in trials.
