Have you read the announcement page and wondered what happens on Saturdays at JEC? It's actually a busy place in the mornings serving our community.

Every Saturday, classes for English as a Second Language (ESL) are held. Our volunteers teach beginning and intermediate English classes. We have about 10 to 15 immigrant community members who come each week to learn English words, explanations of some of our holidays, and practice English conversations. Classes are held from 9am to 12pm. As a JEC volunteer, relationships are built through time spent together, words exchanged, and shared experiences. volunteer or join as a student. We want everyone to feel God's love in His house.

On every third Saturday, SERVE continues to feed our neighbors physically and spiritually. Last month, 123 families were served. There was plenty of produce, but the pantry items fed only half of the families. Before our neighbors come, the volunteers have to decide which foods we have to limit or provide a choice. For example, we had 40 packs of chicken and 48 cartons of hummus. The neighbors got to choose either a pack of chicken or a carton of hummus. So, we will continue to ask for monthly donations to help with our supplies.

This month's donation item is still chicken broth. May will be canned corn. Please place your donations in the foyer. God is good and He does provide even when we have doubts. Come join us on the third Saturday to spread God's abundant love to our neighbors.
