A begat B who begat C who begat ...zzzzzz

Last year I purchased a Read-Through-The-Bible-in- pointing the way to Jesus Christ, even through 'the One Year Bible that the church was selling. When I read through the Bible continuously from Genesis to Revelations, I found new insights into reading the New Testament and it was easier to read through, rather than just studying random verses.

It was however challenging to get through the Old Testament, and I found it difficult to get meaning from it, especially when you get to the 'who begat who.' I found myself just getting through the genealogy sections as quickly as possible.

God however gave us the Old Testament for a reason, and it wasn't just for the history of the Jewish people. This year, Teresa and I started a video Bible study that that goes through the entire Bible in one year. In the YouTube series called *Heart Dive* with Kanoe Gibson, she made the point

that the entire Bible and the Old Testament is about begats.'

I found this particularly interesting and revealing. In Genesis 5, it gives a genealogy of Adam to Noah. When the Bible gives a genealogy, it's for a purpose. Adam begat Seth, who begat Enosh, who begat Kenan, who begat Mahalelal, who begat Jared, who begat Enoch, who begat Methuselah, who begat Lamech, who begat Noah.

Now if we look at the meaning of those names, Adam means 'man', Seth means 'placed and appointed', Enosh means 'mortal', Kenan means 'sorrow', Mahalalel means 'Blessed God', Jared means 'shall come down', Enoch means 'teaching and anointed', Methuselah means 'his death will bring', Lamech means 'disparaging taste', and Noah means 'Ultimate rest and comfort'.
