2 Corinthians 12:1-10

Paul's silence over his heavenly revelation is broken only by this boast in his weakness. The result was Christ's power resting on him and working through him.

Here are Paul's "visionary" principles:

1. Not e	, but e	(12:1-5)
2. Not e	self, but e	God (12:6-9)
3. Not t	, but t	(12:10)

God's denial of Paul's (short-sighted) request turned out to be for Paul's greater good because it was to God's (far-sighted) glory.
