Proverbs 11:30 | *The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life. And he who wins souls is wise.*

STEPS FOR GREATER PRODUCTIVITY

1. FOR SWEETER _____ GROW DEEPER _____

The fruit of the righteous... **Proverbs 11:30a**

Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in him. He will be like a tree planted by water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when the heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit.

Jeremiah 17:7-8

The righteous cannot be uprooted. **Proverbs 12:3**

2. DON'T NEGLECT PULLING _____ AND PRUNING _____

... is a tree of life. **Proverbs 11:30b**

The seed is the Word of God....The seeds that fall among [weeds] stand for those who hear; but the worries and riches and pleasures of this life crowd in and choke them, and their fruit never ripens. **Luke 8:11, 14**


