Navigating Change

Just like the changing seasons and Daylight Saving Time, churches are constantly changing. New members join, old members depart, the culture of the church may shift over time, but the Gospel should always remain unchanging. While change can be unsettling, it is also an opportunity for growth and renewal. Here's an analogy of seasons to help navigate through church transitions

Spring is a time of new beginnings. The days get longer and warmer, flowers bloom, and animals emerge from hibernation. In church, spring might represent a season of new leadership, ministries, or focus. During Spring it is important to be adaptable and faithful. Prepare to let go of old ways, and also guard against a consumer mentality of jumping ship. And remember that it takes time for growth.

Summer is a time of growth and abundance. The days are long and sunny, and crops are ripening. In church, summer is a time of increased activity and momentum. Volunteers step forward, new demographics emerge. It's important to be intentional about discipleship in summer. With the increased activity, it's easy to leave discipleship and mentoring as an afterthought. We also need to beware of becoming complacent. Just as summer ends, so too will this season of growth.

Fall is a time of slowing and preparing for winter. The days get shorter and cooler, leaves change color, and animals prepare for winter. In church, fall is a time of slowing momentum or plateaued ministry. During fall, we must be prayerful and wise. We review our church's mission and vision, and make sure that we are aligned with God's will to prepare for winter's challenges.

Winter is a time of rest and reflection. The days are short and cold, and the ground is snow-covered. In church, winter represents decreased activity, an aging demographic, or focus on inward growth. During winter it's helpful to focus on our relationship with God, and be open to new things spring will introduce. We need to be patient and trust that God is working in our church, and be careful of being consumers instead of servants.
