Thanks to your mission offerings, Journey supports nine missionary teams of varying amounts. Some are doing sensitive missionary work so we don't publish their names. Recently your mission committee (the GO Team, **G**lobal **O**utreach Team) has reached out to your small groups to be more aware of their current needs so that you can support them in prayer. If you have any questions, please ask GOTeam@journeyec.org. Here are some highlights and prayer requests from the prayer letters of a few of our supported missionaries:

K&L (Turkey)—Supporting earthquake relief efforts by buying and delivering humanitarian goods, building homes for those that lost their homes, visiting families affected, and teaming with others. Pray that the Lord leads them to those whose hearts are truly open to God. Journey will launch a fundraising drive for their relief efforts.

G&J (Indonesia)—Praise that their daughter got married in April, and for travel mercies through Malaysia (possibly Brunei too) for a trip with a ministry partner.

SR—Training and ministering to indigenous leaders who are reaching the unreached in Asia and India. Recently spoke at a leadership retreat in Malaysia. Pray that SR was used to minister to the key leaders and that their ministry would expand to reach even more international ministry leaders.

I&S—Living out God's love with Muslims in North Africa, participating in fasting during Ramadan. Pray for I's dad's recovery at home, comfort for their friend's family who lost a loved one due to cancer, and for the Lord to minister to them as they say several "goodbyes" his month and the future.

AJ—Ministering to victims of sexual violence in Guatemala. Pray for the girls to find healing and restoration, for the growing student leadership team to be equipped, and for a new devotional series "Women in the Bible" to inspire the girls to see how God worked through and transformed women leaders in the Bible. Also for AJ and his wife of one year as they transition into a new home.

P&Z—P is finalizing Northern Thai New Testament translation, and working on an Ephesians translation for the "D" people's group. P appreciates prayer for wisdom and perseverance. Z hosted a successful fundraising dinner for the university and is the new coordinator for the Certificate in Applied Linguistics program. Z appreciates prayer for strength and wisdom.
