#### **Advent Season**

Believers and churches all over the world celebrate Advent from December 3<sup>rd</sup> to December 24<sup>th</sup>. The word "advent" means arrival or coming of a person, thing, or



event. In Christianity it refers to Jesus' First Coming as a baby in Bethlehem, as well as His Second Coming for His Bride.

Five candles are lit for Advent, three blue or purple, one pink, and one white. Each one represents something different, and serve as a reminder that Jesus came as Light into our dark world.

- **1. Candle of Hope** (Isaiah 7:14). The first candle symbolizes hope and is also referred to as the "Prophet's Candle." The prophets of the Old Testament, especially Isaiah, waited in hope for the Messiah's arrival. Hope is like a light shining in a dark place. Our hope is only found in Jesus Christ, who offers undeserved forgiveness for our sins.
- **2. Candle of Love** (Luke 2:12). The second candle represents love and is called "Bethlehem's Candle." Micah foretold that the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem, which is also the birthplace of King David as an expression of God the Father's love for all peoples.
- **3. Candle of Joy** (Luke 2:8-12). The third candle symbolizes joy, also called the "Shepherd's Candle." The angels announced to the shepherds in the field, "good news of great joy to all people." This candle is pink because, in Christian history, the color rose signifies joy.
- **4. Candle of Peace** (Luke 2:8-11, Angel's Candle). The fourth candle represents peace. The angels announced that Jesus came to bring peace with God as well as with each other.
- **5. Candle of Light & Purity** (Christ Candle). The fifth candle is white and it represents Christ coming into the world with light and purity. It is placed in the middle as a reminder of the preeminence and centrality of Christ. This candle is usually lit on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day.

May these Advent Candles help you visually center Christmas on our beloved Christ, the ultimate source of our hope, love, joy, and peace.
