The Gospel Story, what Jesus did, chs. 1–3

We are loved (1:3–14), We have resurrection power (1:15–23),
We are saved from sin (2:1–10), We are made one (2:11–22),
We portray His beauty (3:1–13), We're filled with God's fullness (3:14–21)

Our story, how we live out the Gospel, chs. 4–6

We are called to walk in unity (4:1–3)
with five _____ to preserve the Spirit's unity
When people see that we are one, the world will know Jesus, (John 17:23)

Seven Exclusive Marks of Unity, 4:4–6

- 1. One Body:** the Spirit baptizes us into one body, there is only one church
- 2. One Spirit:** all other spirits are _____
- 3. One Hope:** Jesus' return, as revealed by the Spirit (1:17–18, Titus 2:13)
- 4. One Lord:** we are saved in Christ alone (Jn 14:6; Acts 4:12)
- 5. One Faith:** we are all sinful, but Christ died in our place
- 6. One Baptism:** to publicly _____ identifying with Christ (Rom. 6:3-6)
- 7. One God:** not many gods, all others are false idols (Deut. 6:4)
