The Gospel Story (what Jesus did), chs. 1–3

Jesus died and rose to offer the **free gift of salvation**, all **spiritual riches**, and **unity**

Our Story (how we live out the Gospel), chs. 4–6

God calls us to mature **unity** by living out **five attitudes**, 4:1–3, 13

defined by the **seven marks of unity**, 4:4–6

built up by varying measures of **grace** given to individual believers, 4:7–10

and the **five equipping offices**, 4:11–14

Christ has given each believer different _____ of grace, 4:7

(cf. Eph 3:7, 1 Cor. 12:7, Rom 12:3–6, 1 Pet 4:10).

The gifts of grace are to build His Church in unity, not to _____

Jesus Christ triumphed victoriously, 4:8–10a (cf. Psalm 68:17–18, Col 2:15, Eph. 1:20–22)

He ascended to heaven and distributed the spoils of victory

When we use our gifts to build His Church, Christ fills all in all 4:10b

(cf. Phil. 2:9, Eph. 1:20–23, 2 Tim 2:12, 1 Cor. 6:3)
