 - Introduction to beloved Tychicus (Τυχικός, "fortune" or "lucky")
 - Paul desires total transparency, cf. 1 Thessalonians
 "Shared joy is double joy, shared sorry is half a sorrow"
 - Purpose for transparency: to ______ hearts

2. **Double blessing**, Ephesians 6:23–24

- First blessing: "Peace, love, and faith"
- Second blessing: "Grace"
